Oak Grove is an independent school serving preschool through twelfth grade. Founded by J. Krishnamurti in 1975, it is located on 150 acres in the Ojai Valley. The high school offers a four-year, coeducational, college preparatory program accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, NAIS, and CAIS.

admission

Selective. Students must be equipped for a challenging college preparatory program. Maximum enrollment is 60 and is made up of students from the United States and several foreign countries.

faculty

The high school staff includes eight academic faculty and five elective specialists.

graduation requirements

Minimum graduation requirements exceed the entrance requirements for the University of California: four years of English, four years of history and social studies, three years of mathematics, three years of science, three years of foreign language, three years in the arts, and electives to a total of 26 units. Students are strongly encouraged to take advantage of the four-year sequence offered in science, math, and foreign language.

rank

Oak Grove High School students are not ranked.

test scores

SAT I mean scores for the past three graduating classes: Reading: 540, Math: 562, Writing: 565.

calendar

The school year is divided into two semesters. Grades are issued two times a year. Quarterly grades are used to indicate progress and semester grades are recorded on transcripts.

curriculum

College preparatory in accordance with the philosophy and intent of the school. Oak Grove students are encouraged toward intellectual depth, aesthetic and environmental sensitivity, social responsibility, physical vitality, and an open-minded spirit of inquiry. Emphasis is placed on the core academic subjects, an exploration of arts, fitness and health, environmental awareness, and outdoor education. Community service and participation in the Advisory, which explores a variety of issues relevant to young people, is also mandatory.

honors, advanced placement & electives

Honors, AP, and elective courses offered are determined each year according to student enrollment. Typical electives include: Studio Art, Music, Digital Photography and Design, Film Studies, Drama, and Ceramics.
